## Life Span Screening at Activity Center

**Findlay Township will once again host health screenings that could save your life.**

Findlay Township is pleased to offer a preventive health event. Life Line Screening, the nation's leading provider of community-based preventive health screenings, will host their affordable, non-invasive, painless health screenings on December 5, 2009.

The screenings will be held from 9 a.m. - 5 p.m. at the Activity Center located at 310 Main Street, Imperial.
