

**TOWNSHIP OF FINDLAY
ORDINANCE NO. 359**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FINDLAY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, COUNTY OF ALLEGHENY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING CHAPTER 101 "STREETS/HIGHWAYS" OF THE FINDLAY TOWNSHIP CODE AND CHAPTER 83 "PEDDLING AND SOLICITING" ALSO OF THE FINDLAY TOWNSHIP CODE.

WHEREAS, the Township of Findlay Board of Supervisors is empowered under the Second Class Township Code to enact ordinances regulating Streets/highways and Peddling and Soliciting; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors seek to amend Section 101.2.6. under Streets/Highways and Section 83.4 (Disclosure Provisions) under Peddling and Soliciting to include a provision requiring the applicant to provide Township preferred Criminal Background and History Checks; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors seek to amend these Sections, described above, as follows:

Chapter 101 Streets/Highways

ADD 101.2.6. The applicant is required to provide the Township with a criminal history report from the Pennsylvania State Police for any and all employees or independent contractors being utilized/employed at the work site, including all supervisory staff.

AND

Chapter 83 Peddling and Soliciting

Amend Section 83.4 Disclosure Provisions/Criminal Background and History Check

Delete the following."to facilitate a criminal background check, which the Findlay Township Police Department conducts for the purpose of crime prevention."

ADD the following as replacement."as part of the application process, license applicants under this Chapter 83 must provide the Township with: information such as full name, height, weight, hair color, eye color, date of birth, current residential address, all residential addresses for the prior three (3) years, photo identification and business information if engaged in or representing a business and a report of criminal history background report from the Pennsylvania State Police with, the Findlay Township Police. Such report of criminal history record

information shall be no more than six (6) months old.”

83.5 Procedure For Issuance of License

Any person seeking a license shall apply by completing and submitting an application form, including the required disclosure information, criminal history background report and applicable fee.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors intend to protect the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Findlay and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same.

This authorization must be accompanied by the appropriate signage for enforcement capability.

Repeal. All ordinances or part of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

Severability. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable, and any part of this Ordinance found to be unconstitutional or contrary to statute shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance, which shall remain in effect.




